## PFT RITMO powercoat in Large-Scale Project

One of the first large-scale projects in which Mr. Vos used his new PFT RITMO powercoat was an order carried out in Oberhausen (North Rhine Westphalia). From October 2007 to February 2008, his workers used the machine to apply a filling compound to the precast concrete ceilings of 65 flats. These flats were designed for occupancy by elderly and disabled people. The contractor of this large-scale building project, Bangel Industriebau, had charged construction engineer Aymen Arem with the coordination of the work. Bangel Industriebau, a full-service

provider of planning and execution, is one of the leading specialists in commercial and industrial construction in the state of North Rhine Westphalia.

## First Manual, Then Mechanical Application

The plasterers first filled the joints between the precast concrete elements by hand. Then the complete ceiling surface, approx. 5,000 m<sup>2</sup> in area, was coated with the machine-applied filler Knauf Multifinish M. The job was really child's play, thanks to the use of the PFT RITMO powercoat mixing pump with a long spray gun.
