

24 Staircases – One PFT SWING II

Saving Time, Labour and Money with One Small Machine.



With suitable accessories, everything goes like clockwork: The PFT spray gun allows the workman to easily and uniformly apply the material.

For a large-scale project, namely the renovation of 24 staircases with a spray-applied putty coat, master painter Thomas Albert from Baunatal (Central Germany) was looking for a small, light and handy machine that would help him to accomplish renovation jobs and minor tasks economically and independently of a power connection.

Mr. Albert found the suitable equipment during a system training course organised by PFT partner trader Thiel Baumaschinen in Vellmar.

These intensive course on the

use of machines not only provide theoretical tricks and tips, but also practically teach how to „keep things moving“ with PFT equipment. In such a training course, Mr. Albert noticed the small, mobile feed pump PFT SWING II. The first practical demonstration of this machine immediately aroused enthusiasm in him.

The subsequent on-site demonstration convinced Thomas Albert so much that he bought a PFT SWING II straight away.

The first major application of the new PFT SWING II was the above-mentioned large-scale project of renovating 24 staircases. The project comprised several three and

four-storey multifamily houses in Stadthallendorf, whose staircases had to be completely re-plastered with a spray-applied putty coat.

Since the houses were inhabited during the renovation phase, fast and clean work was needed. After Mr. Albert had briefly shown his employees how to use the machine, everything went off without a hitch. The putty

material to be spray-applied was fed to the stainless steel hopper of the machine, and the 1.1 kW direct drive unit conveyed the granular material up to 20 m.
